Jurmala School of art is organizing the 20th International Visual art competition 'I live by the Sea'. The theme of the competition varies every year but the sea is always a focal point. Everyone can live by the sea, even if it is by a sea of flowers or a sea of sand. We all have our sea of dreams and we all share the pleasure of creative working: drawing, painting, or creating things.

The motto of our school is "It is an art to create Art". We are inviting everyone to create art. Children and young people from countries all over the world are invited to participate in the competition.

THEME OF THE COMPETITION:

"On the Shoulders of the Water God"

- **Personal myths and legends**

Anyone who has been to the sea at least once as a child has encountered a magical story or a mythical adventure with seemingly no logical explanation. Those who grew up near the sea get to it better. Their childhood memories also have a story or a game related to the unknown nature, joy, fear, magic of the sea.

This year competition focuses on the personal mythological experience related to the sea and how this experience has created habits, rituals, traditions, and their reflection in art works. We invite young artists to indulge their deepest childhood memories, lifetime

experiences or feelings created by the inexplicable.

- **Games and plays**

The theme invites us to remember childhood games and activities, in which something of the mysterious rite of eternity or the ceremony of "secret knowledge" of adults is manifested, to learn the twists and turns of nature and human driving forces.

Life cannot be put into structures or systems, it is much deeper, more unexplorable, sometimes incomprehensible, and therefore magical.

**AIM OF THE
COMPETITION:**

Using artistic expressions, encourage everyone's interest in the ecosystem of water (springs, rivers, lakes, seas, and oceans), its role in the development of human life, culture, and traditions, as well as evaluate water as an intercultural unifying element.

**TASKS OF THE
COMPETITION:**

- Encouraging children and youth for creative self-expression and motivating competition participants to express their individuality and artistic imagination in visual art.
- Stimulate children's and youth's interest in the environment and their national culture and traditions.
- Giving children and youth a possibility to get to know nature, culture, and traditions of other countries.
- Creating an opportunity to exchange experiences among children, youth, and teachers, and giving them the possibility to make new friends, find new cooperation partners, and create new ideas.

**THEME OF THE
COMPETITION:**

On the Shoulders of the Water God

- Personal myths and legends.
- Games and plays
- Myths from the peoples living by the sea.

PARTICIPANTS:

- Children and youth of age from 4 to 19;
- Works can be submitted by educational institutions, public organizations, and individuals.

AUTHOR OF THE WORK:

AN INDIVIDUAL

ARTWORK DIMENSIONS:

- Only originals will be accepted; Work copies (Xerox, electronic, etc.) will not be evaluated;
- Participants shall submit two-dimensional works;
- Work dimensions - A3 format (30 × 42 cm) or A2 format (42 × 60 cm); Silk screen press works can be A4 format (21 x 29, 7 cm);
- Computer graphics works and photos will be accepted only printed on good quality paper. Edges of the work should not be less than 1000 pixels;
- The artworks are not be framed except artworks of category "Textile"
- The frame of the artwork of the category "Textile" should be thin and light.

NUMBER OF WORKS:

- An individual may submit **a maximum of 2 (two) works**;
- Educational institutions may submit **no more than 5 (five) works from each age category and technique category.**

**EVALUATION OF
WORKS:**

AGE CATEGORY:

- 4-7 year old;
- 8-11 year old;
- 12 – 15 year old;
- 16 – 19 year old.

Computer graphics works and photos are evaluated in 2 age categories:
8 – 13 year old;
14 – 19 year old.

TECHNIQUE CATEGORY:

- Paintings (Gouache, acrylic, tempera, watercolor, oil color, oil crayons, mixed techniques);
- Graphics (Silkscreen press, pencil, color pencils, Indian ink, charcoal, sepia, sangin, gel pens, markers);
- Computer graphics;
- Photography;

- Textiles – (presentation thin, light).
- EVALUATION CRITERIA:**
- Work adequacy to the competition theme;
 - The author's creative idea;
 - High-level artistic performance.
- IN ADDITION::**
- Works made by children and youth with special needs are evaluated in a separate category.
- JURY:**
- An international jury has been approved by the organizers of the competition.
The jury consists of professional artists.
- The jury reserves the rights:
- To change the prize distribution by category.
 - Not to evaluate the work of the competition, which does not comply with the theme or terms of competition.
 - Not to award any medal.
 - To award a number of first, second, or third place.
 - To award special prizes for a particular performance.
- PRIZES:**
- Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals will be awarded for each technique and age category.
 - Grand Prix will be awarded for each technique category and one age category 8 – 19 year old.
 - The jury will also award incentive prizes, acknowledgments, and diplomas for successful themes revelation, and artistic performances.
 - In addition to the international jury, works may be evaluated by other Latvian organizations, the children's jury may also be set up.

Applications are accepted until March 20th, 2023

WINNER AWARDING:

The award ceremony of the winners and opening of the best works exhibition will take place at Jurmala School of Art exhibition hall and Jurmala Music School exhibition hall.

The exhibition will be open until end of August.

**ORGANIZERS'
RIGHTS:**

- The organizers of the competition provide the requirements of the Personal Data Protection Law. The personal data of participants of the competition will be used only for the purposes of the competition in accordance with the European Data Protection Regulation.

- During the event participants may be photographed or filmed; photos and audio-visual material can be published for non-commercial purposes

- The participants give up all copyrights of submitted artwork to the organizers of the competition without reward. Organizer becomes the owner of the works, submitted to the competition. The organizer reserves a right to publish and exhibit artwork.

- Organizers may keep artworks for an international traveling exhibition, or for a different type of presentation needs, with a reference to the author;

- The artworks may be published by the organizer on the internet and social media for non-commercial purposes.

- After the closing of the exhibition organizers do not guarantee storing the artworks.

- The organizer does not return submitted works after the competition, and the work will not be sent back by mail.

- When submitting a work to the competition, the participant simultaneously confirms, that the content of the work submitted for the competition is an original work – it has not been copied from works created by other authors without their consent. The participant confirms that the content does not infringe the rights of third parties;

- The organizers of the competition do not take any responsibility for possible conflicts between persons who dispute copyright

- When submitting a work to the competition, the participant grants to the organizers of the competition irrevocable and territorially unrestricted copyright, including the right to exhibit, publish, distribute, use the work for publicity, including in the Internet environment and handouts;

- The participant of the competition retains the author's personal copyright, including the right to a name, as well as the property right to the work. When the competition organizers use the competition work in any form, the name of the competition

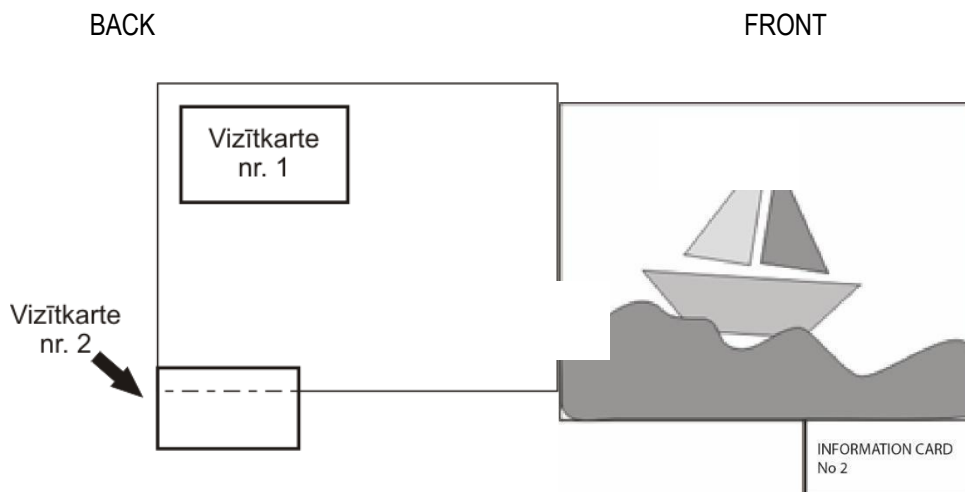
